

Confessions for No Fear

•The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? - Psalm 27:1.

•I will be strong and of good courage. I will not be afraid or dismayed, for the Lord my God is with me wherever I go - Joshua 1:9.

•The Lord [God] Himself has said, I will not in any way fail you nor give you up nor leave you without support. I will not, I will not, I will not in any degree leave you helpless nor forsake nor let you down (relax My hold on you). Assuredly not!
