IT IS ABUNDANCE TIME

In this lesson you will learn that it is abundance time of people coming into the Kingdom of God and abundance time of prodigals coming back to the Lord – abundance time of joy, peace, love, provision, and finances.

- I. It is abundance time.
 - A. Ephesians 3:20 – “Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us.”
 - B. John 10:10 – “I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.”

- II. You will receive abundance through faith and love.
 - A. 2 Corinthians 4:13 – “And since we have the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, ‘I believed and therefore I spoke,’ we also believe and therefore speak.”
 - B. Matthew 22:37 – “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.”
 - C. Faith and love connect you with God’s unlimited ability.
 1. It is time to be a believing believer.
 2. You will possess what you confess (Mark 11:24).
 3. Whose report will you believe?

- III. You have been redeemed from the curse of the law.
 - A. Galatians 3:13-14 – You have been redeemed from poverty, sickness, calamity, disease, and spiritual death.

- IV. Enter into the commanded (unstoppable) blessing of God – 1 Kings 17:1-16.
 - A. When Elijah did what God told him to do during a time of famine, he was provided for and so was the widow woman.
 - B. God has assigned you to be a blessing on the earth today. Believe for abundance to use what you have to bless other people.

- What and who are you listening to?
- What do you believe will happen in your life in your present and in your future?
- What is coming from your mouth? What are you saying?

BE A DOER OF THE WORD

This week make a decision to believe the report of the Lord. Don’t participate in the recession. Move from being a decrease thinker to an increase thinker and from having a poverty mentality to a prosperity mentality.
