THE POWER OF YOUR WORDS - PART 5

This lesson has excerpts from chapter 7 of the book, *The Power of Your Words*, by Pastor Daugherty.

Your words will bury you or they will resurrect you. They will take you over the top or put you under. The topic of your words in the Bible isn't a side issue. It's at the very core of the Word of God!

- I. Reaping the harvest of your words.
 - A. Galatians 6:7 Whatever a man sows, that he will also reap.
 - B. Proverbs 6:2 You are snared by the words of your mouth.

- II. Your confession will bring possession.
 - A. Psalm 19:14 This verse says that our words are to be acceptable in God's sight.
 - B. You are called to speak words of life, which are words that agree with God's Word.

- III. Jesus whipped the devil with words.
 - A. Matthew 4:1-11 The devil tempted Jesus three times and Jesus overcame the temptations with, It is written, then quoting an appropriate Word promise.

- Share something that you are confessing over your life.
- How have you used "It is written" to change your circumstances?
- Is there an area of your life that you would like to undo negative words and begin to speak God's Word?

BE A DOER OF THE WORD

Speak this confession every day this week: *I am more than a conqueror through Jesus Christ. Greater is He who is in me than he who is in the world. The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not lack or have want of anything. My cup runs over. Jesus came that I might have life and have it more abundantly. This is my day of abundant life. This is the day the Lord has made, and I'm going to rejoice and be glad in it. The joy of the Lord is my strength. Thank You, Lord, that Your mercies endure forever, and they are new to me every morning.*

SCRIPTURE MEMORY VERSE: Psalm 19:14 Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in Your sight, O Lord, my strength and my Redeemer.
