

Confessions for Peace

- You will keep me in perfect peace, because my mind is stayed on You, Lord - Isaiah 26:3.
- I cast down imaginations and every high thing (thought) that exalts itself against the knowledge of God and I bring into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ having a soberness and readiness in my mind to avenge my rebellions or disobedient thoughts - 2 Corinthians 10:5-6.

- I let the peace of God rule my heart and act as the umpire of my life - Colossians 3:15. (The umpire of a baseball game calls the plays in the game. Whatever he says is the final word. I let God's peace have the final word in my life.)
- Great peace have they who love thy law, and nothing will by any means offend them - Psalm 119:165.
- I follow after (pursue) peace with all men and holiness without which no one shall see the Lord - Hebrews 12:14.
- I give no place to strife because where there is strife, there is confusion and the opportunity for every evil work - James 3:16.
- I am blessed because I am a peacemaker - Matthew 5:9.
