- **2. Draw near to God.** Heb 10:22 WEB Let us draw near with a true heart in **full assurance** of faith... Rom 4:21 WEB And being **fully persuaded**, that what he had promised, he was able also to perform.
- **3. Speak (echo) God's promises back to Him.** (The mouth must engage with the heart). Rom 10:10 KJV For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
- **4. Patience.** Heb 6:12 NIV We do not want you to become lazy, but to imitate those who through **faith and patience** inherit what has been promised.
- **5. Forcefully resist the enemy by name.** (Say "yes" to God and "no" to the devil.) Luk 8:30 KJV And Jesus asked him, saying, What is thy name? And he said, Legion: because many devils were entered into him. Jas 4:7 KJV Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
