**A Worthy Walk**

**Key Passage: Ephesians 4:1-6 NKJV**

I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you **to walk worthy of the calling** with which you were called,<sup>2</sup> with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love,<sup>3</sup> endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. <sup>4</sup>*There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling;* <sup>5</sup>one Lord, one faith, one baptism; <sup>6</sup>one God and Father of all, who *is* above all, and through all, and in you all.

**Introduction:**

As believers in Christ, we are to walk worthy of the calling that Christ has called each one of us to.

**Walking Worthy of our Calling means walking in:**

1. **Humility (V. 2) – Romans 12:3** “For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think of *himself* more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith.”
2. **Gentleness (V.2) – Proverbs 15:1** “A soft answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.”
3. **Patience (V.2) – I Corinthians 13:4** “Love is Patient, love is kind...”
4. **Bearing with Each Other in Love (V. 2) – Galatians 5:22-23** “But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup> gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.”
5. **Making Effort to be United in Peace – Ephesians 4:3**
6. **We’re All A Part of the Same Family – Ephesians 4:4**

1. What is the “walk” that God has called you to in this season?
2. What areas in your life challenge your “love walk”?
3. Are there any areas that you have been challenged to walk in unity and peace?
