#### 1. Five were foolish

Mat 25:2 AMP - "Five of them were foolish [thoughtless, silly, and careless], 3 "For when the foolish took their lamps, they did not take any [extra] oil with them,

- **2. Five were wise** Mat 25:2 AMP "Five of them were ... wise **[far-sighted, practical, and sensible]...**4 but the wise took flasks of oil along with their lamps.
- **3.** When the groom arrived, the foolish were shut out. Mat 25:10 AMP "But while they were going away to buy oil, the bridegroom came, and those who were ready went in with him to the wedding feast; and the door was shut and locked.

- **1.Stay filled with the Holy Spirit** Eph 5:18b AMP ...but be filled with the [Holy] Spirit and constantly guided by Him.
- **2. Spiritual preparedness and active and ongoing faith.** Mat 5:14a NKJV "You are the light of the world..."
